



2 It's important to make sure that the paper is creased well. Run your finger over the crease two or three times.



3 Refold the crease you just made into a mountain fold, then unfold. Open up the corner slightly.



4 Open up the paper a little more and then tuck the tip of the point inside. Close the paper. This is the view from the underside of the paper.



5 Flatten the paper. You now have an inside reverse fold.

OUTSIDE REVERSE FOLD

This is great if you want to make part of your model stick out. It will come in handy for making heads and pointed hats.



1 Fold a piece of paper diagonally in half. Make a valley fold on one point and crease.
