Wallace Stringfellow

nickname: 32 (number as a baseball player)

ethnicity: African American iob: police constable in Chabot

interests: baseball

character traits: proud as a young boy, athletic, outspoken, but tries to evade responsibility for his acts, shows courage when he finally confesses and exonerates Larry, feeling of duty

towards Larry (bad conscience)

relationship with other characters: mother Alice Jones, father Carl Ott (which he did not know), former friendship with Larry (his half-brother), former interracial relationship with Cindy Walker, girlfriend Angie, respected in town

death: died in car accident (drunk driving, alcoholic)

ethnicity: Caucasian iob: mechanic

character traits: rebellious, manipulative

relationship with other characters: idolised by many of her peers, dysfunctional family (stepfather Cecil molests and probably kills her), secret relationship with Silas, takes

advantage of Larry's admiration for her

character traits: racist, abusive

relationship with other characters: Carl Ott's drinking buddy. Cindy Walker's stepfather (molests and behaves sexually inappropriate towards her, probably her killer)
